DOUBLE DECKER BUSES

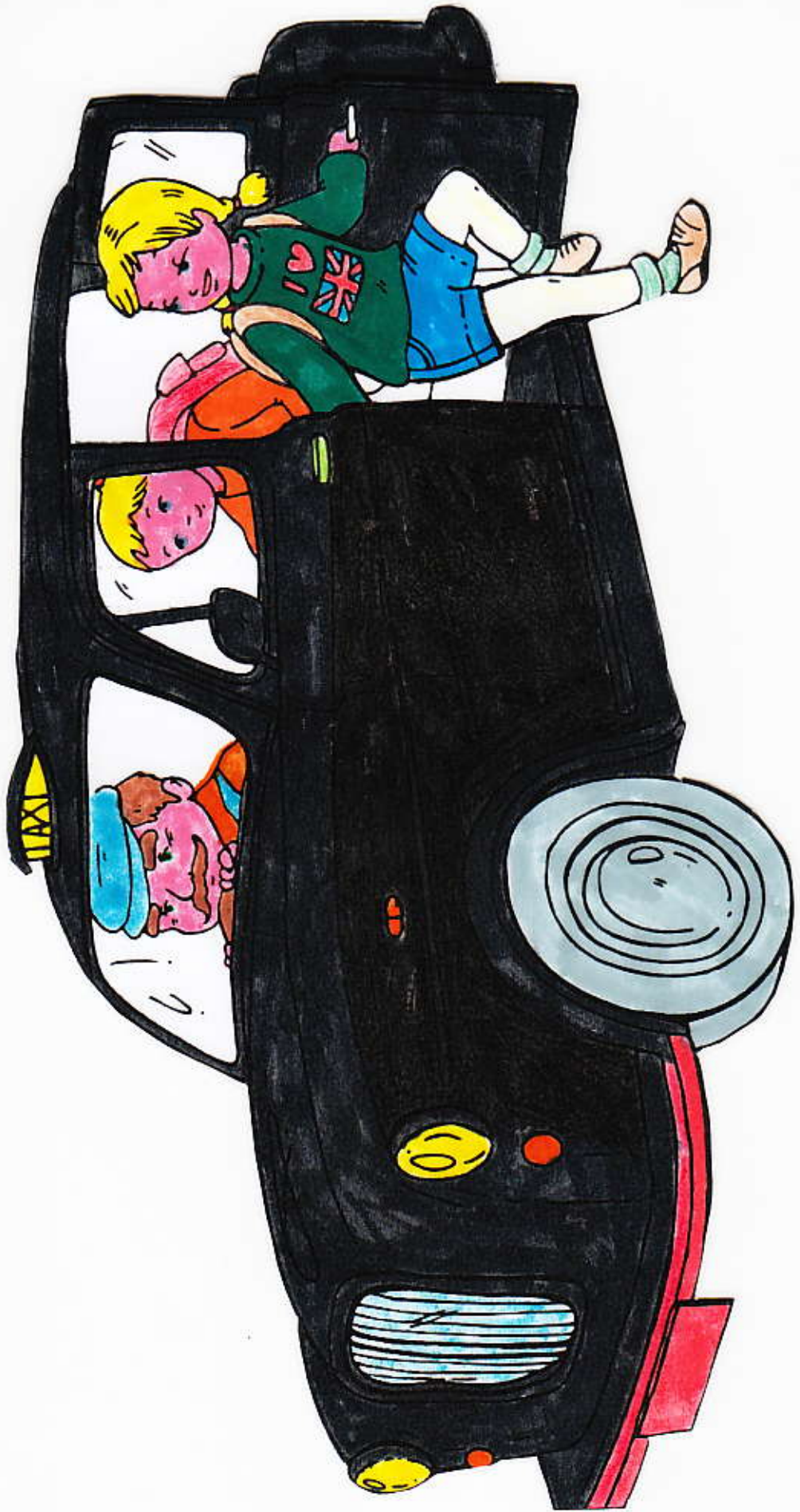

Double decker buses are also used in cities in Europe, Asia, and former British colonies and protectorates such as Hong Kong, Singapore and Canada. Almost all double decker buses have a single rigid chassis.
